The Council of the City of Alexandria, Louisiana, met in a regularly scheduled meeting session at its regular meeting place, on Tuesday, May 31, 2016 at 5:00 P.M. Those present were the Honorable, Roosevelt Johnson, Jim Villard, Jules Green, and Ed Larvadain. Also present were the Council Staff and Council Attorney Trey Gist.
