ITEM #1

An Application has been submitted by Rapides Parish Police Jury represented herein by, Tom David whom is requesting a **VARIANCE** to be exempt from dry floodproofing requirements in a Flood Zone. The property is located at 711 Washington Street, Alexandria, La. The said property is described as:

LOTS 1, 2, 4 & A PORTION OF LOT 3 SQUARE 57, LOCATED IN SEC.7, T04N R01W ***PARCEL I.D. # 2400700180023701 ***

The Applicants request is to be allowed to be exempt from dry floodproofing a new building being constructed that would serve as a Courthouse Administration Annex facility. The said property is located within the CBD (Central Business) District, and the building would be within a Special Flood Hazard Area (Zone AE) thus requiring a **VARIANCE.** If granted, the Variance would not exempt flood insurance requirements.
