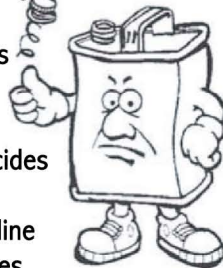

## WHAT IS HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE?

*Household hazardous waste is any product labeled: toxic, poison, corrosive, flammable, combustible, or irritant.*

## THINGS TO BRING

- Cell Phones and Chargers
- Used Motor Oil
- Antifreeze
- Brake Fluid
- Pesticides
- Thinners
- Pool Chemicals
- Chlorine
- Home Hobby Supplies
- Corrosive Chemicals (lye, acid)
- Photographic Chemicals
- Floor and Furniture Polish
- Drain Cleaners
- Spot Removers
- Fluorescent Light Bulbs
- Batteries-Auto, Rechargeable, Alkaline
- Expired Prescription Drugs



## DO NOT BRING

- Ammunition
- Tires
- Lab Waste
- Commercial Waste
- Explosives

## HOW TO PREPARE YOUR MATERIALS

- Seal the material in its original container, if possible.
- Wrap glass bottles in a cloth, newspaper or other packaging material to prevent breakage.
- Place material in a cardboard box.
- Place the cardboard box either in the trunk of the car or in the bed of a pickup truck.
- Keep material away from passengers.
