The Council of the City of Alexandria, Louisiana, met in a regularly scheduled meeting session at its regular meeting place, on Tuesday, March 22, 2016 at 5:00 P.M. Those present were the Honorable Lee Rubin, Roosevelt Johnson, Jim Villard, Jules Green, Ed Larvadain, Chuck Fowler and Harry Silver. Also present were Mayor Roy and Chuck Johnson from the Administration, Council Staff and Council Attorney Trey Gist.

The Council of the City of Alexandria, State of Louisiana, was duly convened as the governing authority of said City by the Honorable Lee Rubin, who stated that the Council was ready for the transaction of business. The Invocation was pronounced by Mr. Silver and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mr. Johnson.
