- Works to build a sense of community and encourages positive human relations among all
- Exemplifies a positive attitude toward improving human relations among all people.
- Consistent living of one's own life with a sense of responsibility for the welfare of the community.

Business and Organizations - Profit/Non-Profit

- Encourages diversity in the workforce
- Provides leadership and directions for all employees
- Promotes and participates in activities and programs that promote a sense of responsibility for the welfare of the community.

Youth/Emerging Leader (ages 18 and under)

- Is active in community/civic affairs above and beyond their educational requirements or duties of their job.
- Works to build a sense of community and encourages positive human relations among all people.
- Exemplifies a positive attitude toward improving human relations among all people.
- Consistent living of one's own life with a sense of responsibility for the welfare of the community.
